



Ned Kelly Helmet

You will need:

- Black A4 cardboard
- Single hole punch
- Safety scissors
- Hat elastic (allow about 25cm per child)
- Metallic markers

Instructions:

1. Cut about 1 cm off each long side of the cardboard until half-way down the sheet, so that the top of the mask is narrower than the bottom.
2. About 5 cm down from the top and 5cm in, punch a hole. Use this as a starting point to cut out a rectangular hole for the eyes. Note: do not try to stab the scissors through the cardboard to start the rectangle.
3. Use the hole punch to make 'bullet holes' on the bottom part of the mask in a random fashion (the real Ned Kelly's mask did have these at the end).
4. Also punch two holes on either side of the eye hole.
5. Decorate the mask with metallic markers.
6. Tie elastic through both holes created in point 4.
7. Put on and enjoy.
